Highway Asset Management – An Introduction

This course provides an introduction to Highway Asset Management. It explains the concept of Asset Management and covers all the key components.

The training will cover:

- The basic principles of Highway Asset Management and how these differ from traditional practice
- What the core components of an Asset Management 'system' are
- How to develop simple lifecycle plans for Highway Assets
- The role of information management in supporting good Asset Management practise
- To understand the content and importance of an Asset Management plan
- The relationship between Asset Management and financial planning and the appropriate use of asset valuation outputs

Who should attend?

This course is aimed at Technicians, Graduates and those new to the industry. The introductory course can be followed by the Highway Asset Management Practitioners Course

Practitioner Training

This assessed course delivers learning across the wide diversity of subjects an Asset Management Practitioner needs.

Students attend two residential sessions of three days each and complete knowledge tests and an assignment. The assignment demands around 5 day's preparation at work or in your own time. Line managers are expected to mentor and support their staff and are welcome to attend at a heavily discounted rate.

The training will cover:

- Introduction to Highway Asset Management
- Asset Information Management
- Lifecycle Cost Analysis
- Risk Management in the context of Asset Management
- Service Standards & Performance Management
- Contract management & procurement
- Asset Valuation and financial planning
- Long term investment planning and value management
- Building a business case
- Programme management

The course is based around the CSS Framework for Highway Asset Management, and the Codes of Practice for Highway Management coupled with a variety of other relevant national and international texts.

To gain the full IHIE Professional Certificate, candidates will be required to present their assignment and be interviewed by assessors who measure them against the IHIE's Asset Management competence assessment framework. Successful candidates will be awarded the IHIE's Asset Management Practitioners Certificate.

Who should attend?

This course is aimed at Engineers and Technicians who are currently in an Asset Manager role.
