The Institute of Highway Incorporated Engineers can now offer all routes to Chartered Engineer registration thanks to a new license from the Engineering Council which holds the CEng title.

Commenting on the license extension, IHIE President, Susan Broadway said "IHIE is proud to now be able to offer CEng routes to new and existing members. We are really excited by extending IHIE's reach to chartered level. It endorses our professional standing and creates new opportunities for our members. The benchmark academic entry standard for CEng is now a MEng or Masters but older degrees are still acceptable and other applicants can progress through further learning or by the technical report route. Senior IEng's with significant design experience are likely to be among the first tranche of applicants. They may be able to demonstrate masters level knowledge through a training and development report of further learning.
